Education Abroad Ambassador Objectives

Professionalism and Public Speaking

Ambassadors take part in a training session prior to the start of classes and are routinely joined at monthly meetings by staff members who present to them on their responsibilities and experience. Ambassadors are trained to present a general PowerPoint during classroom visits and University events.

Communication and Accountability

Through peer advising, Ambassadors interact with students on a weekly basis developing the skills to effectively listen to the goals of perspective participants and guide them to resources. Ambassadors also learn the importance of dependability and communicating whether they are able to fulfill a commitment.

Teamwork

Ambassadors participate in monthly meetings during which they engage in activities designed for them to further get to know each other and work together. They collaborate to create, advertise, and implement events. At least two Ambassadors are requested for each tabling opportunity.

Reflection

At monthly meetings, students will be asked to engage in discussion activities that reflect on their experience abroad. This is also a time for Ambassadors to think about their advising experience, ask questions, and discuss any concerns.
